- Benefits in profitability and processes
- Benefits to environment and energy use
- Benefits for work load and safety

SYSTEMS & COMPONENTS TROPHY – Engineers' Choice



To win a Trophy, **systems or components** must feature a new or distinctly improved concept that can contribute significantly to developing and realising products which facilitate the use of new processes or substantially improve already familiar processes.

An independent expert commission composed of members from science, research and consulting will convene and select the winners.

Information on innovations submitted will be treated in strict confidence and will be viewed only by the expert commission.

A jury of development engineers from exhibiting agricultural engineering companies will select the award-winners in a two-step process:



Step 1: Pre-selection from all applicants by 20 development engineers from the overall jury: Viewing all documents, technical assessment and nomination of 20 innovations.



Step 2: Selection of the award-winners from the 20 nominated innovations through online voting of the overall jury.
