Submit your topic

Application:

Please submit an abstract of your presentation by 30 June 2021. The abstract should include the following:

- Meaningful title of your contribution
- Personal details of the speaker (title, first name, surname, position in the company, department, address, telephone number and e-mail)
- Summary with key message of your contribution
- Statement on the degree of innovation
- Assignment to the thematic focus
- Indication of own publications on the topic.

Presentation format:

- Specialist lectures
- Panel discussion

(Length of presentation is 20 minutes, followed by 10 minutes to discuss your presentation with the auditorium.)

Conference language:

- German
- English (preferred)

- Speakers participate free of charge. Travel expenses will not be reimbursed.
